

Overview

WELS supports cross-cultural outreach at congregations throughout North America. Much of this work centers around diaspora (people group) connections, where immigrants who have joined WELS congregations in North America are able to take the gospel back to friends and family in their home country. The Pastoral Studies Institute (PSI) works alongside many cross-cultural ministries to provide pastoral training for their leaders, allowing them to continue working within their individual ministry context.

The Joint Mission Committee helps facilitate this cross-cultural outreach. It is made up of representatives from Home Missions, World Missions, and Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary.

Cross-cultural outreach in your community

Is your congregation interested in sharing the gospel with a specific people group in your area? WELS provides support through volunteer stateside pastors, known as Diaspora Ministry Facilitators (DMFs), who have experience working with various cultural groups. They can assist your outreach efforts and help build connections between local immigrant communities and World Missions teams in their home countries.

Globally, PSI supports Christians seeking gospel training, providing consultation, curriculum support, and advanced degree programs for seminaries and Bible institutes.
